


WHATS COMING DOWN THE PIPE IN THE GARDEN



JUNUARY IS NEARLY DONE

Garlic Scapes...yum!

Scapes are the fresh shoot of growth at the top of your garlic at this time of year, if left on the plant it will flower and produce bulbils (seed).

To maximize bulb size, cut off the scapes (the curling tip) just as they begin to curl. Most wait until it makes a full pigtail curl, and you can use scissors, or snap them off. They are delicious!



You probably haven't had water on your garlic for weeks due to our recent prolonged rainfall, but you should turn your water off a couple of weeks before harvesting your bulbs.

HILLING OF

POTATOES

STAY ON TOP OF IT

Once the foliage has reached 6-8 inches in height (likely a few weeks ago for those with excellent sun exposure), mound soil from the aisles up to 4" high on the plants, repeating every couple of weeks until the hills are 12" high. Hilling protects the developing tubers from greening. Do not fertilize the foliage in prolonged wet weather, it encourages foliar fungal disease.











SUCCESSION PLANTING

If you are looking to make the most of growing food or flowers in your garden, succession planting is the practice of seeding a new crop at the right time to grow a 2nd, 3rd, 4th or more generations of plants to maturity before the hard frost comes in the fall.
