Planting season isn't over!

Keep planting so that you can keep harvesting!

To produce the most produce possible, it's important that gardeners keep planting! Either in areas of their beds that have housed plants that are finished producing or by planting new starters – the art of SUCCESSION planting.



Several vegetables can handle cooler temperature and can be planted later into the growing season. This will vary each year with the date of the first frost.

Plant by the first week of JULY -Potatoes, Zucchini, Parsnip, Green

Beans

Plant by early- to-mid AUGUST-Beets, Carrots, Kohlrabi, Lettuce, Swiss Chard, Turnips

Plant by early SEPTEMBER - Spinach, Radishes, Arugula
