ARUGULA

Germination should take 3–7 days. Keep soil moist to slow bolting. For a continual supply, plant every 2–3 weeks until 1 month prior to first avg. frost date.

HOT TIP! ACTUALLY TRACK YOUR SEEDING DATES.

SPACE. CREATIVITY IN THE HOME GARDEN WILL BE NECESSARY. EDUCATE YOURSELF ON UNDERSOWING, MAYBE YOU CAN FIND SPACE IN BETWEEN YOUR CARROTS ROWS OR UNDER YOUR CABBAGE THAT WILL BE HARVESTED SOON.

HARVEST DURATION. RECORD FOR NEXT YEAR, HOW LONG WERE YOU ABLE TO HARVEST THAT CROP FOR BEFORE NEEDING THE NEXT. THIS VARIES FROM SPRING, SUMMER & FALL DUE TO TEMPS & SUNLIGHT HOURS.
