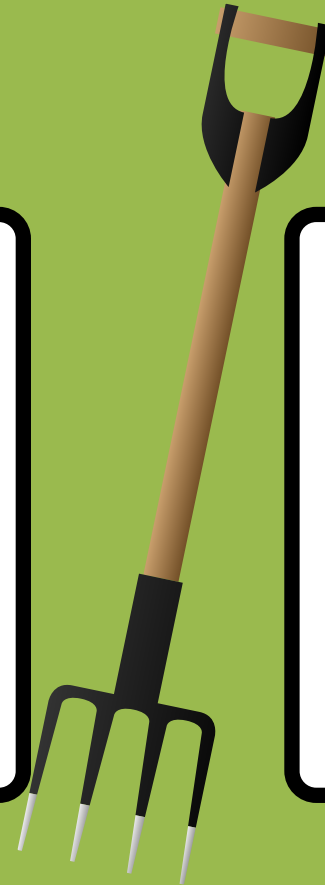

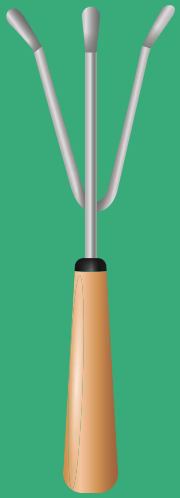
ESSENTIAL FOR

METAL RAKE

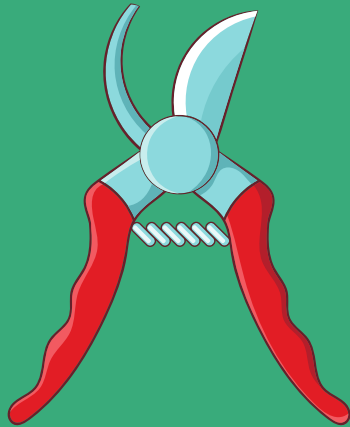
DEALS WITH SOIL,

PLANTS

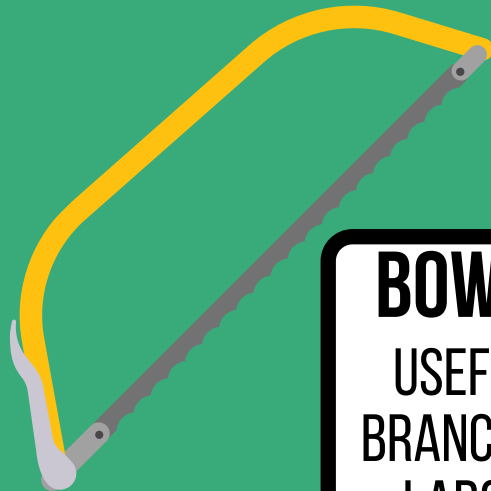
USEFUL TIP: MAINTENANCE IS IMPORTANT! KEEPING YOUR TOOLS SHARP AND CLEAN WILL MAKE THE JOB EASIER AND EXTEND THE TOOLS LIFE. AFTER HEAVY USE, USE A BENCH GRINDER TO GIVE YOUR TOOLS A NEW EDGE. KEEP THEM RUST-FREE BY PLUNGING THEM INTO A BUCKET OF COARSE SAND.

SLEDGE

A SMALL SLEDGE IS HELPFUL WHEN POUNDING IN STAKES AND POLES



BOW SAW

USEFUL FOR BRANCHES TOO LARGE FOR PRUNERS AND DEALING WITH ROUGH CUTTING JOBS



LAWN RAKE

GREAT FOR GATHERING LEAVES AND DEAD VEGETATION
